



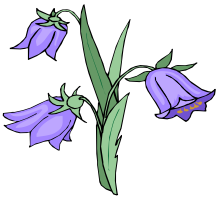

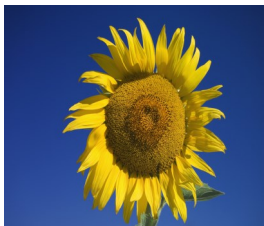
#### EYFS Link - Mathematics & Personal, Social & Emotional Development.

#### Staff News

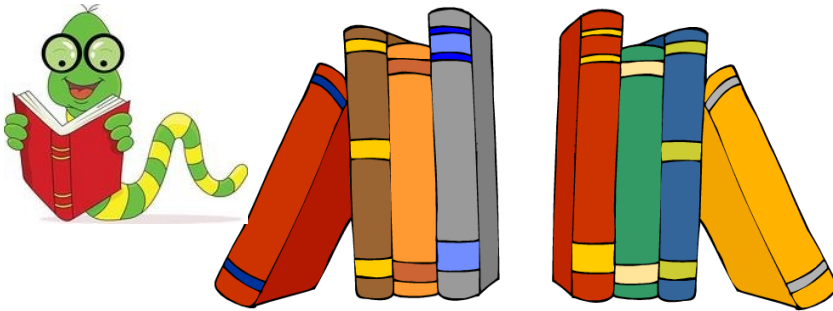
We would like to wish Aisha, Alpna, Farah & Jasvika the best of luck in their new roles and thank them for all their hard work and contribution to the Nursery.
